<i>Focus</i>	<i>Sound</i>	<i>Exercise</i>

Try to find these words in the span of 3 minutes. Then as you are **half-way** through resist the temptation to pull out your phone or google these words. At that point, you should begin to notice the inefficient nature of the print dictionary.
